Basic Needs of Plants

Basic Parts of a Plant

- Seed: Beginning of a plant
- Roots: Anchors the plant, absorbs nutrients and helps to feed plant
- Stem: Moves water and nutrients from roots to leaves
- Leaves: Turn sunlight into food energy for the plant. Also makes oxygen for us to breathe
- Flower: The part that blooms when plant has become an adult
