The Children's Museum of Richmond has always been a hub of creativity and learning, but this year, thanks to your unwavering support, we have reached new heights.

Our dedicated staff, Board of Trustees, volunteers, partners, and supporters enabled us to offer engaging exhibits and programming, ensuring that every visit is filled with wonder **and** educational value. 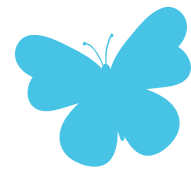

Play with Meaning

CMoR embeds learning opportunities in all we do, for children and caregivers. This year, kids got moving at *CultureFest Fridays*, *Tutus and Ties on Tuesdays*, and in ballet and martial arts pop-up classes, building balance and dexterity skills, and also increasing memory, perception, and language comprehension!

Our educators provided field trips to toddler through grade 3 classes, using the Virginia Standards of Learning. They engaged students in studying habitats, magnets, plant life-cycle, simple machines, and more!

CMoR hosted two Kindergarten Readiness events, equipping families with the essential tools and resources to ensure a successful start to school.

At the 2nd year of *I See Me Play in RVA* (our free family festival) over 1,250 children and caregivers were introduced to fascinating careers while engaging in hands-on activities.

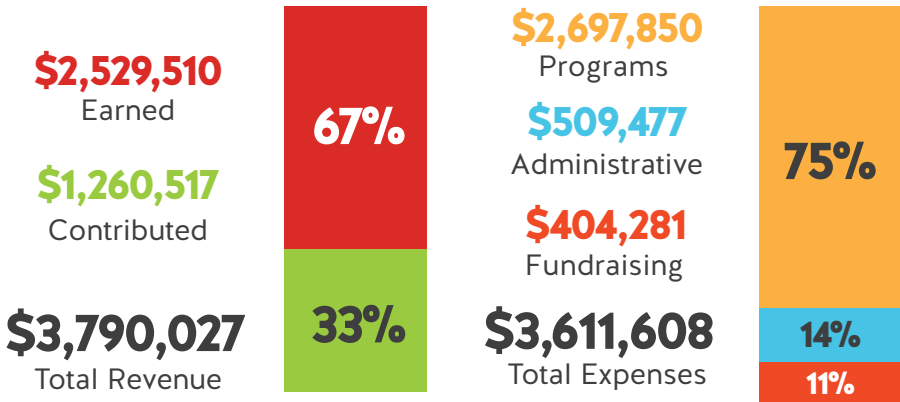
